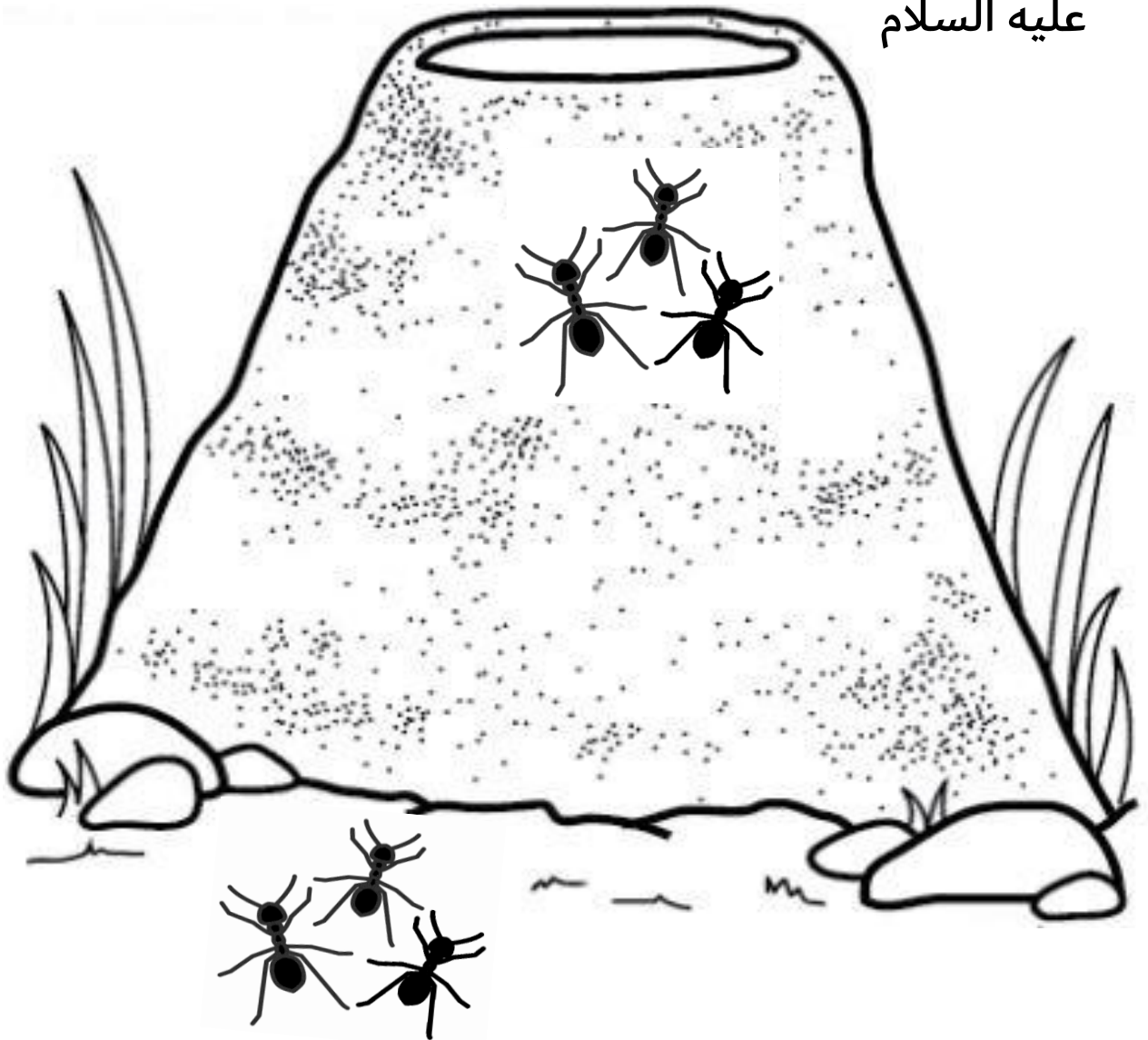

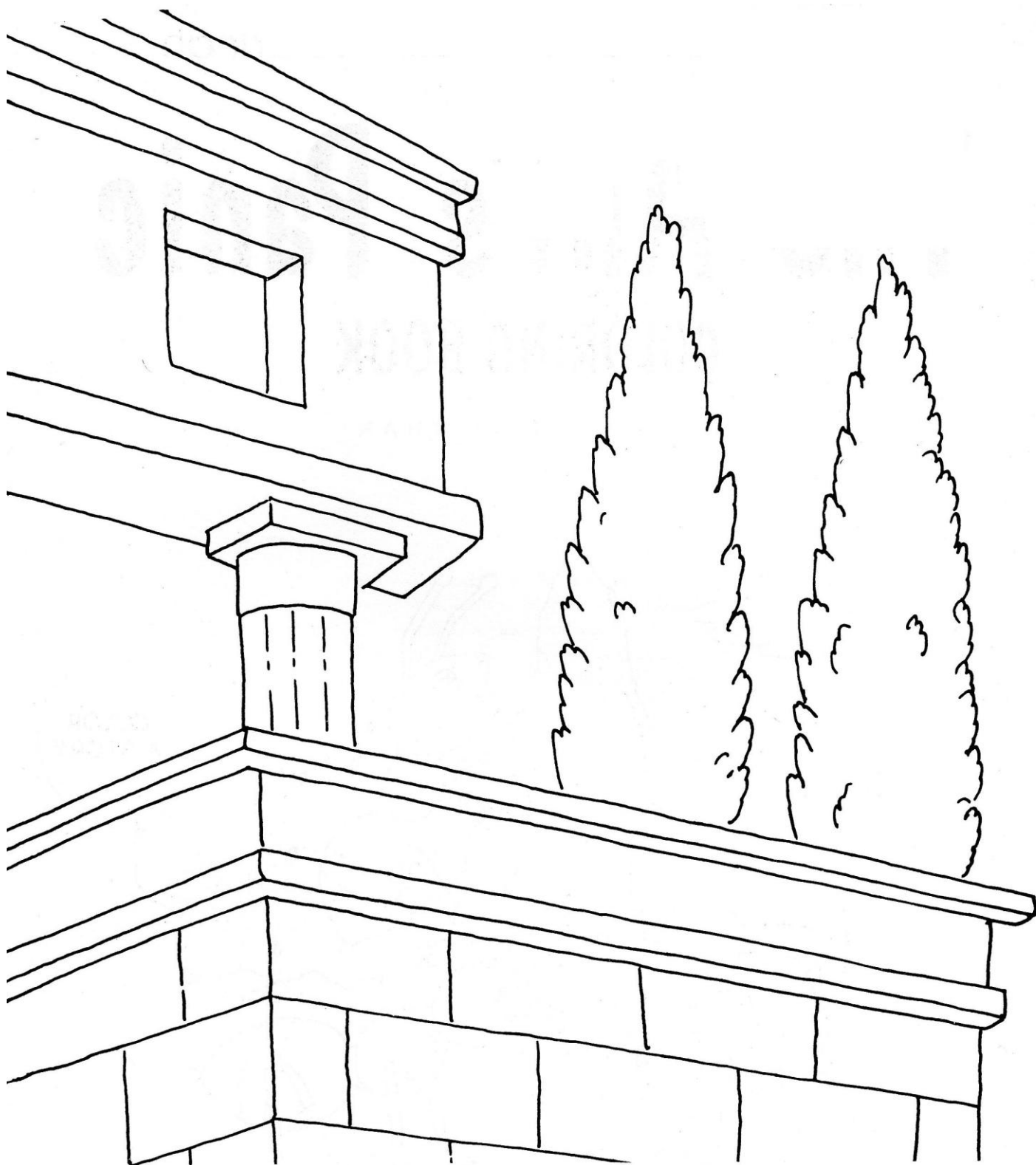

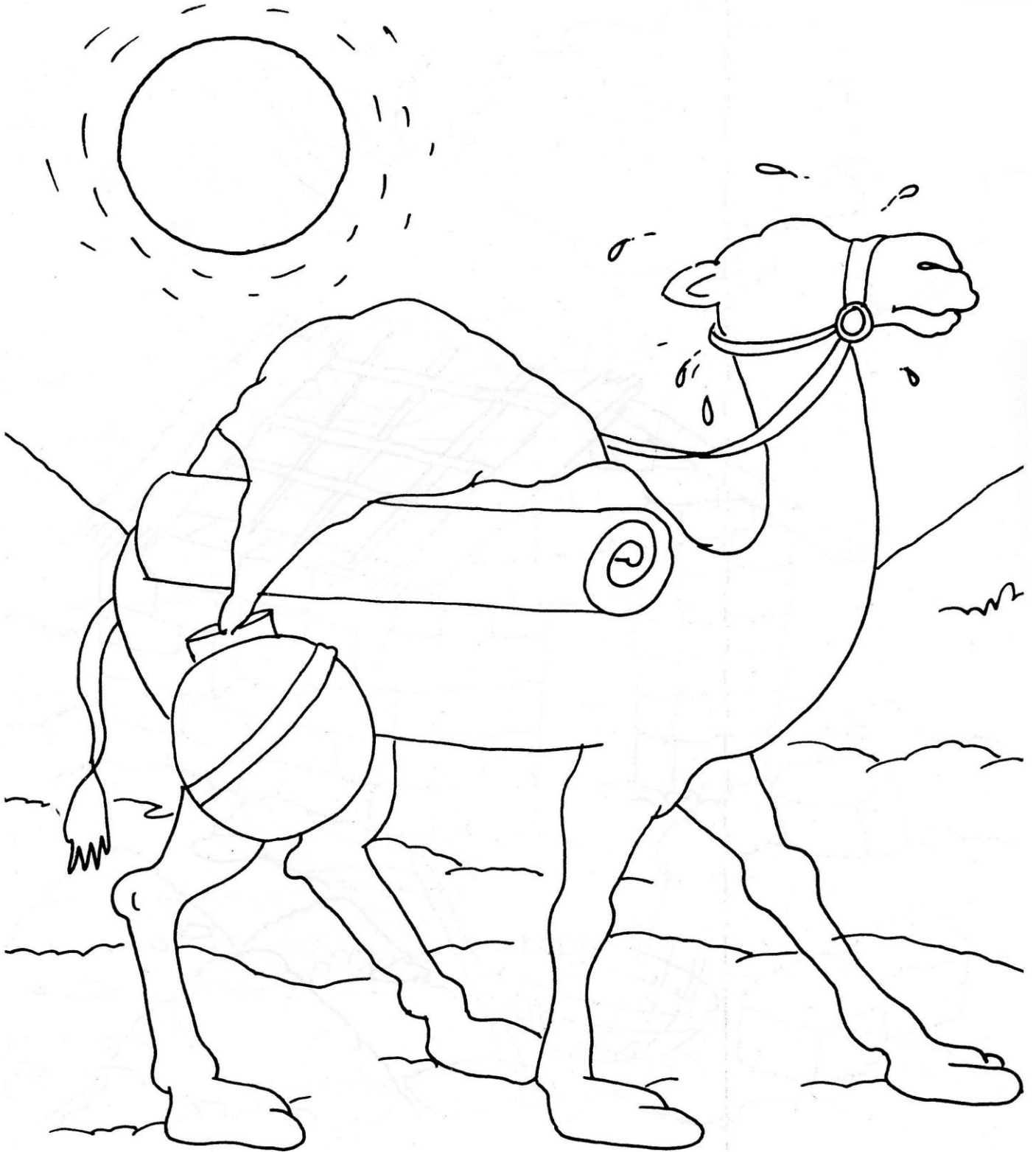
IN THE VALLEY OF THE ANTS

A Story Colouring Book

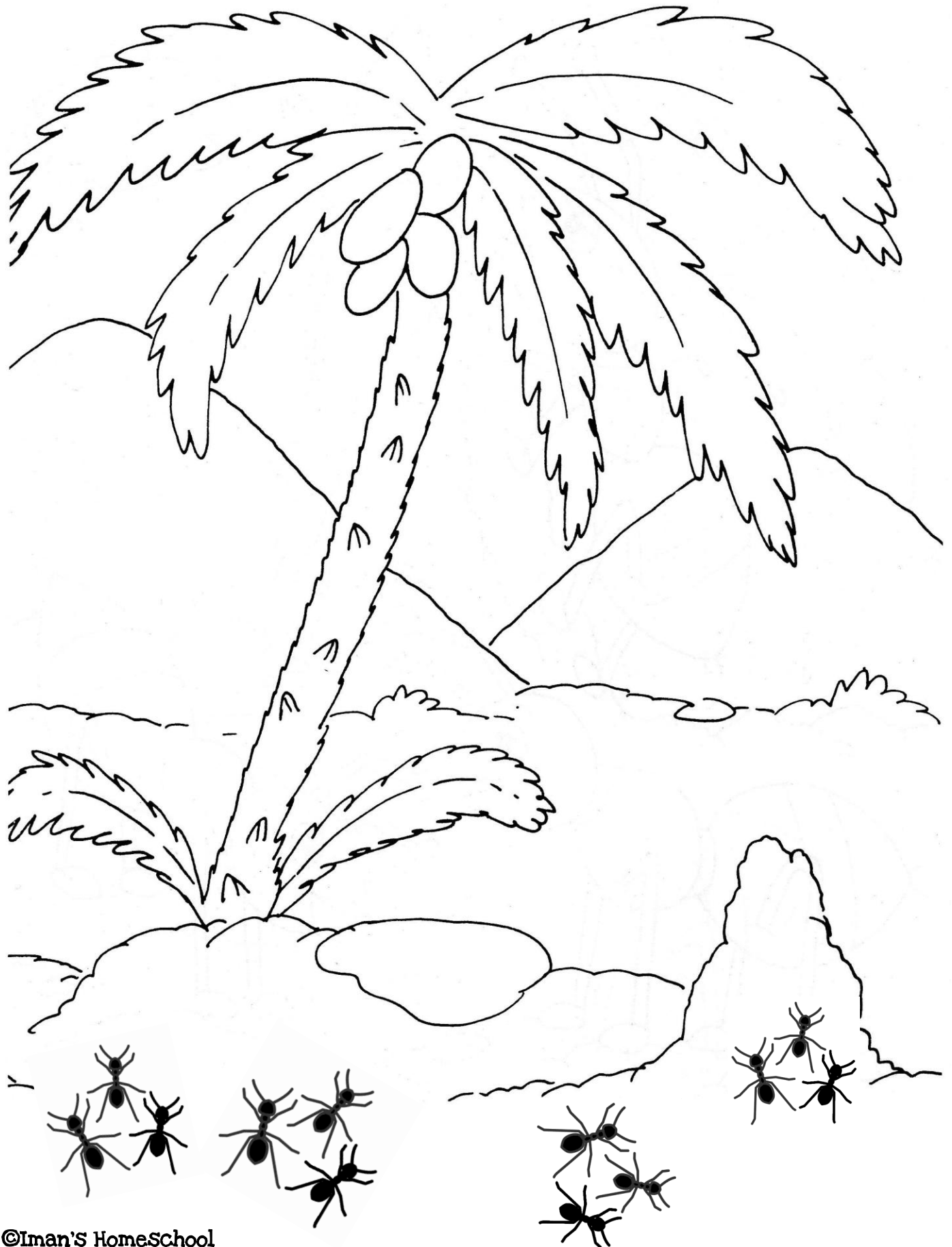

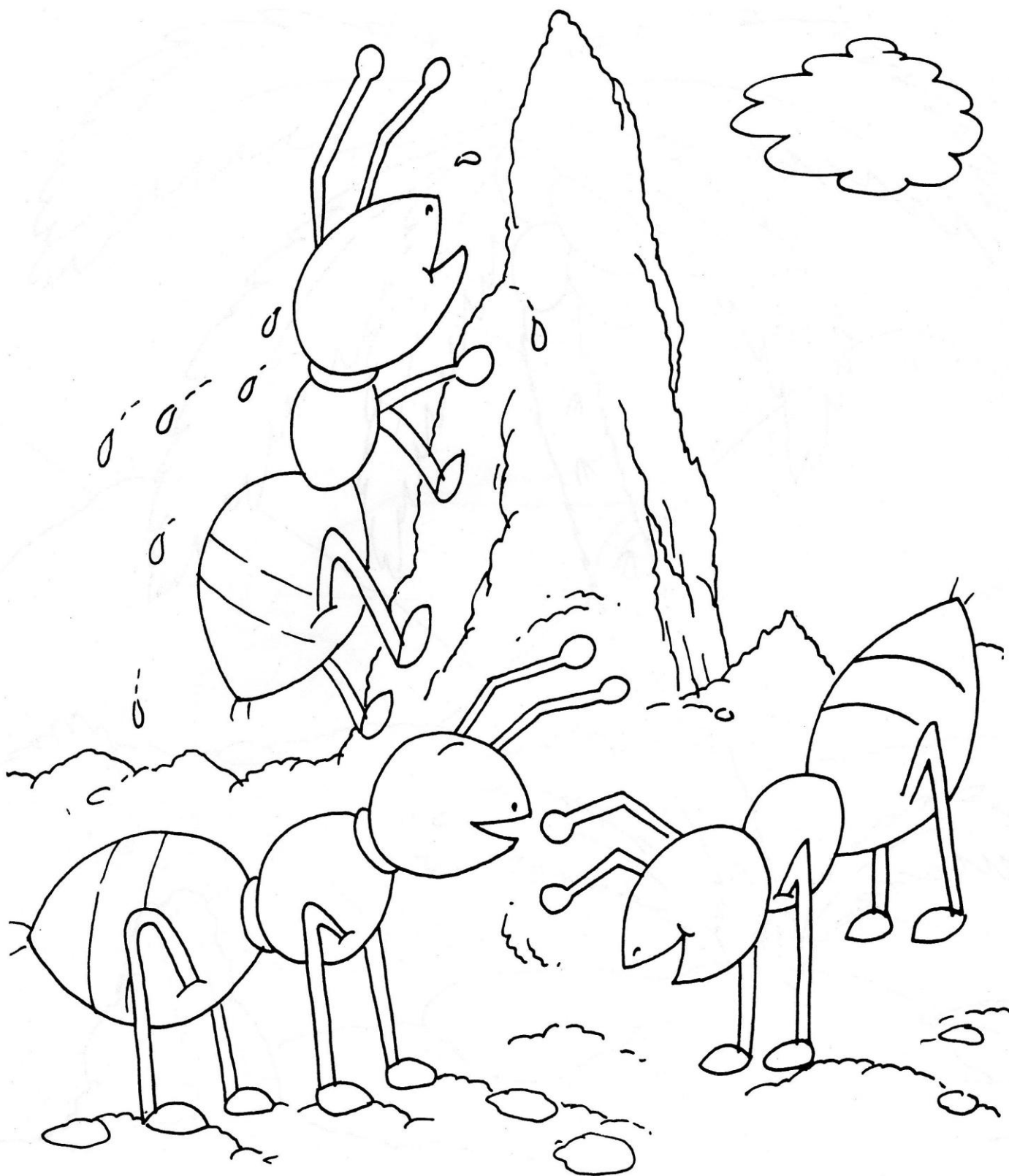

In the valley there lived a large colony of ants.



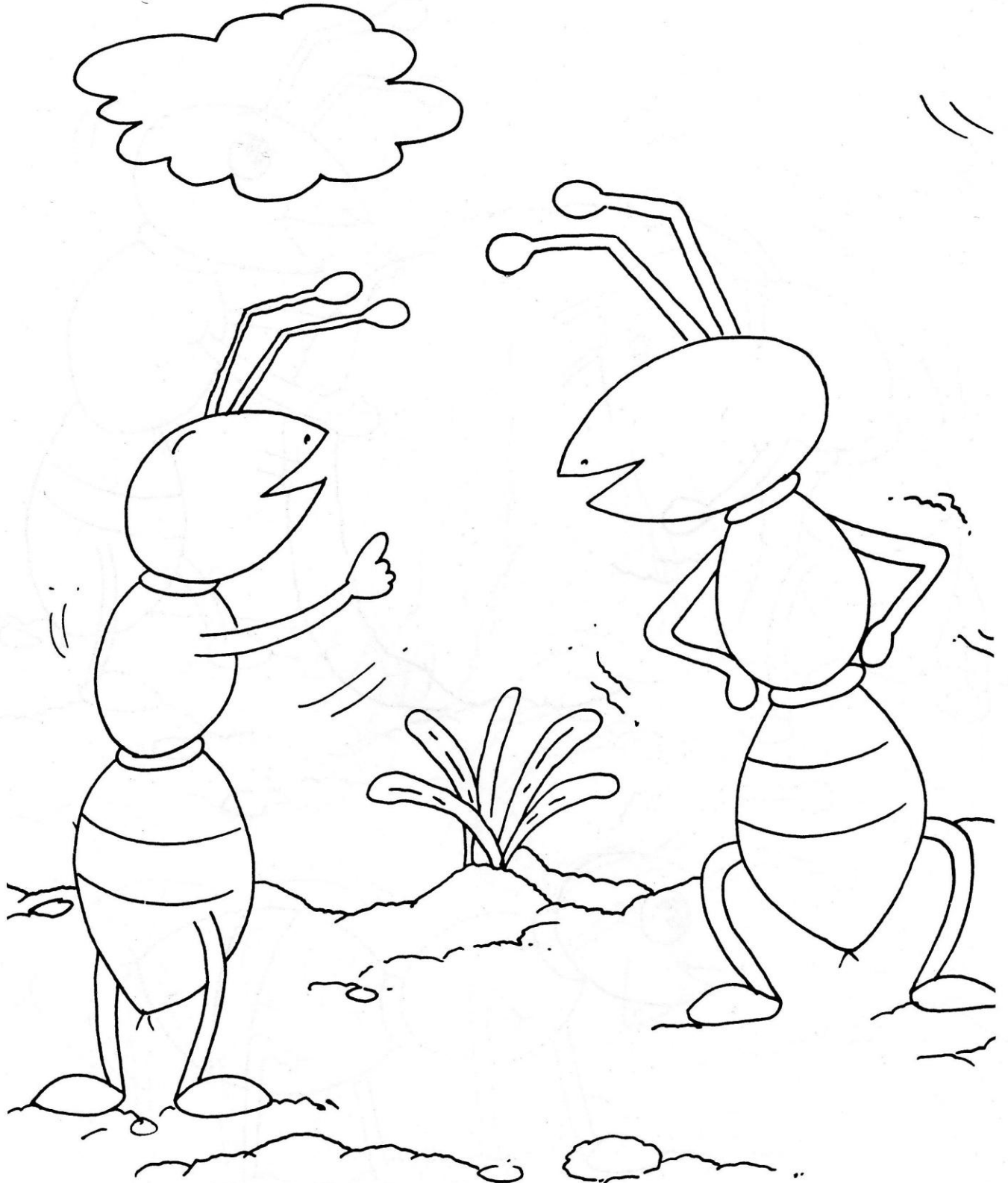
One of the ants saw the army of Prophet Sulayman عليه السلام marching towards the colony so she shouted a warning to the other ants.



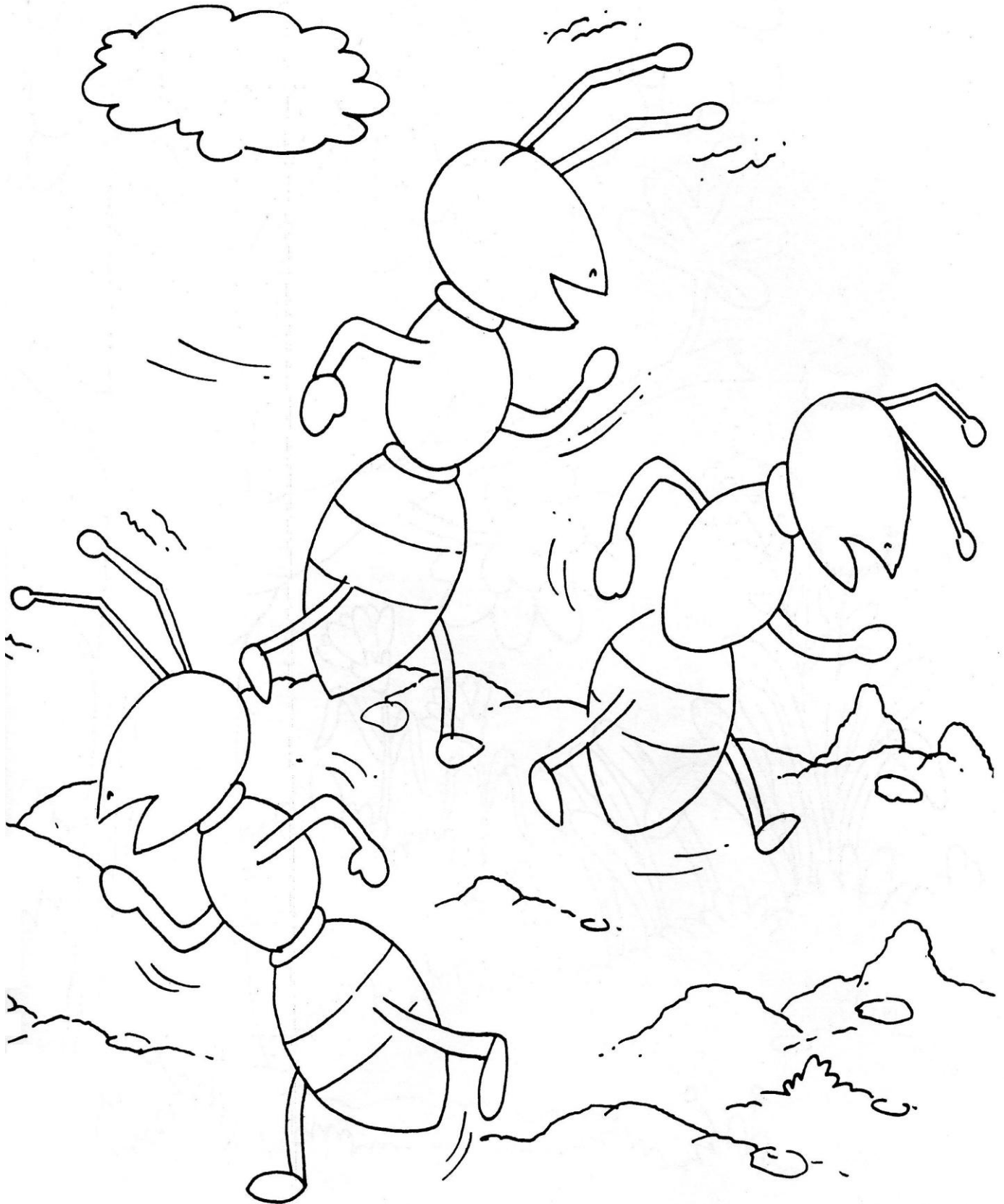
**She said “O Ants! Get into your homes
